#### **Christmas Greetings!**

December 1, 2024, is the first Sunday of Advent which marks the beginning of the season leading up to Christmas. It's always an exciting time of year, and for many, it's a favorite time of year. But it can also be a hectic time of year, of shopping, cooking, caring for kids, finishing school, wrapping presents, attending parties, keeping house, traveling across the country to visit family. However, this Advent season we do not want to add to your list of Christmas to-dos, but to encourage you with what God has already done.

That's why I encourage you to read Isaiah 9. You'll notice that the chapter is cast in the form of a poem, a song even. It's a celebration of HOPE. Against the dark backdrop of national despair and gloom, Isaiah envisions the dawning of the light of salvation (9:1-2), which results in great joy for God's people (v. 3). God is going to bring about liberation from foreign oppressors (v. 4), but more than that, he is going to bring about a complete cessation to warfare itself (v. 5).

How is he going to do that? Through the gift of a son, the birth of a child. "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given" (v. 6a). This is a remarkable answer to all of our problems, isn't it? The birth of a child. God's answer to our big problems is God's coming as a mere child. His answer is Jesus."

This magnificent chapter gives us the prophet's first major exposition of Israel's coming king, her long-awaited Messiah. He'd already hinted at the birth of this world-transforming child earlier in chapter seven, when he announced that "the virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel," (7:14) which means "God with us." But, here, in chapter nine, he elaborates at greater length about who this child will be, using four more names: "And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (v. 6b).
