


Music Notes

Mission Accomplished – Transcriptions Completed

As of July 11, 2025, Mission Accomplished! You say, "What was accomplished?" Is the history book finished? NO, I wished. When Joy Graham and I started late last summer laying out the history book content, a listing of the church membership was considered to be included. By that we meant a listing of names from June 1951 up through late 2025. Just what did that mean and how would we accomplish it.

First, we had to determine where that list resided, in what format, and finally how many names which would result in how many pages in the history book. We knew we had to talk to Teresa Cain in the church office. Of course, she knew the answers or where to find the answers. She told us that the first 50+ years membership rolls were handwritten in two Register Books kept in the Church Office area. The membership roll for the past 15-20 years are kept on the office computer in MS Word and Excel files.

After reviewing the handwritten Register Books, we decided that we needed to copy every page and then scan those pages to make a digital record just in case if something ever happened to the books. Before moving on to scanning, we tallied up how many names were on the membership roll. That number was 2,114 individuals as of 9/14/2014. That number alone could occupy between 20-30 pages depending on the text size used. The concern is book page count for this information since it's not only membership, but also baptisms, marriages, preparatory members, and deaths that all translate to book cost.

After about a week's worth of copying some 200+ pages we completed the copying task. Next the scanning was required which I did on my home scanner. It took about 2 months of off and on scanning, but sometimes for several hours at a time. I scanned each page into both JPG and PDF file formats. Finally, the scanning was accomplished by early September 2024.

The huge task before us was how are we going to transcribe the handwritten pages into digital text so it could be entered into the history book Word file. Initially, I thought we could use the new and emerging technology of Artificial Intelligence (AI) such as Open AI's ChatGPT on the internet which was now capable of reading handwriting and converting it to digital text. This was reviewed and tested for several weeks, but in the end, it was decided for our effort to use the old-fashioned manual transcription of humans reading the scanned files and entering the data into special Excel spreadsheets that looked like the Register book pages.

The manual transcription process would require many volunteers. This is where several ladies in the church stepped up when asked to do the transcriptions. It was not a quick process as it relied on the schedule of the volunteers, about half retired and the other half still working with young children. This process started in early October 2024 and continued until June 2025. This transcription not only included the membership rolls, but also, baptisms, marriages, preparatory members, and deaths. These last categories had a lot less pages and not near as much information as the membership rolls had. The final task was then to get these same volunteers, including Joy

and myself to proofread other person's transcriptions for accuracy. Joy and I made the final decisions on any questioned original book entry by reviewing other church resources.

So, at the end of last week, I finalized all Excel spreadsheets for membership, baptisms, marriages, and deaths for Books 1 and 2. I then made PDF files of all of them too so they can be searched. Copies of the files will be given to Teresa so that she can now search Hawkins past membership rolls without having to use the old register books and manually lookup information.

Again, as of July 11, 2025, **MISSION ACCOMPLISHED!** At this time, I would like to express for myself and Joy Graham many thanks to these ladies for their dedication and persistent work in manually transcribing our Register Books 1 and 2. They are Haley Bell, Jennifer McAlpin, Sandy Berry, Sheila Katzenmayer, Beth Jones, Linda Parker, Joy Graham and Sharon Lantz. Sharon is a former member of Hawkins now living in the Houston, Texas area. I recruited her through a chance meeting of she and her husband Allan at an Ole Miss football game last fall. Thank you, Sharon.
